
Tex ran around the school and jumped over everyone. The kids played with him.

They all ran away. They ran over to the classroom. One of the kittens got stuck on the verandah, and it died. It was a baby kitten.


Now, there were only three kittens left. The kittens still had their mum and dad.


I said, "thank you." And I took the Jewels and put them in my own jewellery box that my Nana and Pop gave me.

The baby python went over to the other snakes and it hissed at them. They all hissed back.





I swam over to the beach and pushed the baby turtle back into the water. I showed it where the nest was.




The baby turtle finally found its mother.
